# **CHALLENGES**

Manual spreadsheet-based processes creating operational inefficiencies

Syndax relied on spreadsheets to manage clinical supply inventory, manually tracking lot allocations, expiry dates, and country releases. As studies increased and drug product lots expanded, this manual process became increasingly difficult to manage. Multiple resources updating files simultaneously led to version control issues, inconsistent data, and frequent errors that compromised operational efficiency.
